All Competitors were born between the year 1976 and 1998. Competitions are held in three disciplines.

6.1 **Borba** - wrestling without strikes and strangulations.

- To 82 kg
- Open (above) 82 kg

Match categories female:

To 50 kg

To 60 kg

Open (above) 60 kg

6.2 **Sam na Sam** - authorized strikes, throws, strangulations (like PRIDE, MMA and K1 fights but held in clothes).

Match categories male:

To 68 kg

To 74 kg

To 82 kg

Open (above) 82 kg

Match categories female:

To 50 kg

To 60 kg

Open (above) 60 kg

6.3 **Stenka na Stenku** – wins is the team that displaces the other team, each team consists of 3 persons (<http://video.stenka.org/video/6>).

RULES & REGULATIONS

FOR THE

World Stenka Championship 2016

The competition rules & regulations are complied with accordance set by the International Stenka Federation version 2007. Should there be any unsettled decision or problem arise which is not set in the Stenka Federation rules & regulations competition therefore the organizing committee have the right to finalized the decision.

1. Registration & Weighing

Registration, Technical Meeting & Balloting will be on 29th October 2016 at 10:00 at **Sport Hall “Maryina Rosha”**.

- 1.1 There will be NO weighing during the registration. However, if the participants which to confirm their weight category they may do so on 29th October 2016. The organizer will follow according to the ‘Entry by Number’ & ‘Entry by Names’ that has been submitted by the contingents earlier.
- 1.2 Changes of names and categories can be made during registration.
- 1.3 Participants have to re-weigh 15 minutes before the competition with standard Stenka attire without body protection and groin guard or other accessories, if they failed to meet the required weight they will be disqualified.
- 1.4 ID must be worn during registration and weighing.

2. Protest

There shall be NO protest. All decision is final.

3. Referees & Jurors

- 3.1 The competitions will be conducted by Stenka Federation referee & Juror holding the International Certificate or Individual Country / States Referee Certificate nominated by the respective Stenka Federation of each country / state
- 3.2 Moscow Martial Arts Federation will be responsible for the accommodation, meals & transportation in Moscow.
- 3.3 One day of refresher workshop will be conducted by appointed instructor holding International Referee Class I on 29th October 2016 at **Sport Hall “Maryina Rosha”, Moscow, Russia**.

4. Technical Meeting & Balloting

Technical meeting and balloting will be on 29th October 2016 at 10:00 hrs held at **Sport Hall “Maryina Rosha”, Moscow, Russia**.

5. Arrival of Contingents

- 5.1 All participants MUST arrive in Moscow, Russia by 28th October 2016, (Friday).

5.2 Contingents have to inform the organizer, details of their arrival latest by the 14th October 2016 and forward the arrival & departure forms through posting, fax or emails at this below stated address:

Participants who wish to come earlier before 28th October 2016 will have to pay on own expenses and transportation. The organizer will assist in the reservation of hotel and transportation.

6. Departure of Contingents

6.1 All contingents have to check out from the hotel on 30th October 2016 by 12:00 hours. 6.2 Transport will be provided from the hotel to Airport / Railway Station / Bus Terminal / Ferry Terminal.

6.3 If any contingents wish to prolong their stay in Moscow and wish to stay in the same hostel or in other hostels/ hotels, please inform the organizing committee in advance so that the committee can make necessary arrangements. The contingents have to pay according to the rate of intended hotels.

7. Transportation

The committee will provide transport for the following needs:

7.1 From the contingents' arrival location to the hotel either at the time of arrival or time of departure and also to competition venue.

7.2 For emergency such as taking someone to hospital, etc.

7.3 The committee will not serve any request for personal needs.

7.4 The committee will provide information about public transportation for those who need it.

8. Meals

All meals will be served in buffet & to be consumed in the hotel or competition venue. The stipulated meals time are as follows:

Breakfast : 06:30 – 08:00hrs (Hotel)

Lunch : 12:30 – 14:00hrs (Competition Venue)

Dinner : on personal account.

11.4 The discipline of ceremonies & competition are as follows:

- Participants must come to every ceremony & event on time according to the schedule set by the organizer.
- Participants must perform good personal appearance with good attitude and spirit of sportsmanship.
- Participants should follow any ceremony orderly during it is taking place, should not utter any noise which might disturb the solemnity of the ceremony.
- Disciplinary action will be taken towards athletes with bad and attitude problems.
- No abusive and vulgarities language / words at all time
- No indecent hand gestures and signs at all time (e.g middle finger, etc)

1st Place – Gold Medal and Certificate for 1 person in each category

2nd Place – Silver Medal and Certificate for 1 person in each category

3rd Place – Bronze Medal and Certificate for 2 people in each category

12.2 Sam na Sam Category

1st Place – Gold Medal and Certificate for 1 person in each category

2nd Place – Silver Medal and Certificate for 1 person in each category

3rd Place – Bronze Medal and Certificate for 2 people in each category

1st Place – Gold Medal and Certificate for three people

2nd Place – Silver Medal and Certificate for three people

3rd Place – Bronze Medal and Certificate for three people

12.4 **Best Athlete Award**

1 Trophy for ‘Female Best Athlete’

1 Trophy for ‘Male Best Athlete’

The winners are based on these criteria:

- How many categories competed
- How many gold medals won
- Good sportsmanship
- How many matches has to fight
- How many fair play winnings

12.5 **Trophies**

There will be 3 Trophies to be won for the competition as stated below. The trophies to be won will be based on the most Gold medals won and followed by Silver & Bronze medals, should there be a tie in the Gold medal or Silver Medal. The Overall Challenge Trophy will only be kept ‘Permanently’ if any of the country / state won 3 consecutively years.

- a) 1 Trophy & 1 Replica - OVERALL CHAMPION CHALLENGE TROPHY (Challenge Trophy to be kept by the current organizer and to pass-over to the next hosting country for the competition. The replica to be kept permanently by the winner)
- b) 1 Trophy - 1st RUNNER UP CHAMPION (trophy to be kept permanently)
- c) 1 Trophy - 2nd RUNNER UP CHAMPION (trophy to be kept permanently)

13. **General Matters**

13.1 All participants for the World Stenka Championship 2016 will be given an ID card.

13.2 The ID cards must be worn throughout the Championship.

13.3 All countries are required to bring along their National Flag (2 pieces) & country National Anthem.

14. **Narcotics**

It is strictly prohibited to bring, consume or to distribute all kinds of drugs or its equivalents in Moscow. Any participants caught or arrested by the authority of Russian Police Force violating the laws will be dealt in accordance with the Court of Laws in Moscow. The committee cannot help anyone involved in breaking the laws against narcotics enacted by the Russian Law.
